Tallantire Wind Farm

Cumbria Community Foundation - Advertising for the Advisory Panel which is not as agreed in the Heads of Terms Agreement. Blindcrake have been included, which was not in the original agreement. RES have made a unilateral decision to include them. Everyone who would like to be on the Advisory Panel are to make an application. Concern was also voiced that decision as to the distribution of the funds will be made by CCF Trustees. Cannot find out what has been agreed between CCF and RES.

It was proposed by Mrs Carol Fossey and seconded by Mr Simon Dumbill that 'Mr Ian McCambridge to represent Bridekirk Parish Council on the Advisory Panel for Tallantire Windfarm Community benefit Fund'. All present were in agreement - there were no abstentions.
